
Welcome to your Story Box Library Trial 15 STORYTIME. ANYTIME.



Dear Librarian,

Welcome to Story Box Library. We are delighted to have your library trialling our wonderful resource with your staff and members.

LOG IN INFORMATION

You should have nominated two sets of log in details when registering for your free trial. Firstly, the Account Holder email/username and password, which are for your sole use as the person charged with managing your public library account. The second set of log in details are known as the Viewer username and password. These details should be provided to your staff to log in. Please do take the time to share these Viewer log in details with your colleagues so they can assess Story Box Library's suitability for use within your library network.

The Viewer username and password are also purely for trial purposes. If you ultimately choose to subscribe, library staff can then simply log in using their own library card barcode number. Account Holder details will remain the same and only need to be used for managing your account.

Please note that while your fellow colleagues are welcome to showcase Story Box Library's offerings to your patrons, only staff, and not patrons, will be able to log into the account during the trial period.

POSTER

In this kit, you will find a poster that you can print out and add your Story Box Library trial dates and Viewer log in details. The poster can be used as a helpful reminder to staff that you have trial access to Story Box Library.

TRIAL PROCESS

Before the end of your free trial period, you will receive a communication from a James Bennett representative to discuss your experience. If you're keen for a quote, you will be asked to provide the population serviced by your library network, as 12-month subscriptions are based upon this information. If you wish to subscribe, then simply inform your James Bennett representative that you accept the quote, at which point you will be contacted to deliver the following information for your account's set-up:

- 1. Your library barcode range or SIP2 details
- 2. IP address/es
- 3. The landing page URL

At this time, you will receive an invoice for your subscription, for which you'll have 30 days to arrange payment. Should you NOT wish to subscribe to Story Box Library, please inform your James Bennett representative via phone or email **storybox@bennett.com.au** to advise of such. If you have any specific feedback as to why your library is not subscribing, we would love to hear from you so that we can continue to improve our product.

AT HOME ACCESS


At Home Access to Story Box Library is also available for your patrons. By providing us with your library's barcode range or SIP2 details, this will enable your patrons to log in to Story Box Library from either within the library or from home. Library patrons will click the Library option on the log in screen to then select your library's name from the drop down menu and enter their library card's barcode number and PIN/password.
